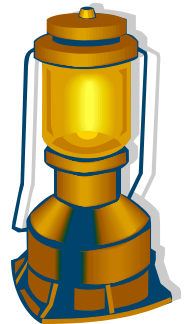
Hurontario is unable to accept any parcels due to the difficulties they create. Thank you for your understanding.
