- Please note there is no bus transportation coming to camp for either the July 12th or August 9th two week sessions. Parents will drive their campers with their baggage to the Moose Deer Point Marina (see map in handbook) to meet the camp staff and boats at the times stated below.
- Please note that parents will be met at the Marina with their camper and all his baggage (back packs, suit case, paddles etc.) labelled with tags on which other information can be written. Please no plastic tags.
- NOTE: Life jackets should be well-named and left out so that they can be worn on the boat trip into the camp. Thank you.

Coming to camp on Monday, July 12 or Monday, August 9th please read on. Please note that there is no bus transportation from Toronto at this time.

- We will meet you and your son with his fully tagged bags at the Moose Deer Point Marina (see map in handbook) ready for a 1:30 p.m. departure into camp.

Coming to Camp on July 12th /August 9th (Cont'd)

- **NOTE:** Please make sure that your son's life jacket with its name clearly displayed is left out of packing as he will wear this into the camp.
- There will be a screening station for all adults, siblings and campers going to the camp.
- The parents and the boys (with their baggage on a separate barge) will then go into the camp together. Please note that there is a charge of \$20.00 round trip (+ HST) for each visitor to be transported to and from the camp. Please see full details re charges for the boy's transportation on Page 6 of Handbook.

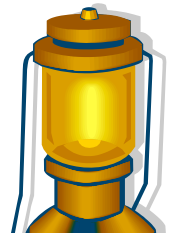
