### Notes:

- All fees are subject to an additional 3% PST and 6% GST.
- Fees may be paid in instalments but must be paid in full before campers arrive.
- The deadline for final payment of fees is May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### **REGISTRATION:**

All parents, whether their boy has attended Camp before or not, are requested to fill out a registration form. Please send this form to the Camp office with the deposit of **\$250.00**. This deposit less a \$100.00 administration charge will be refunded if registration is cancelled before March 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### **REGISTRATION ONLINE:**

Registration forms can be downloaded from Hurontario's web site [www.camphurontario.com](http://www.camphurontario.com). Completed forms can be mailed to the Camp office or faxed to 416-486-0865. A deposit of \$250.00 sent to the Toronto office will confirm this registration.

**As the camp filled quickly last year, we recommend that new registrations be sent to the office as soon as possible in order to confirm a place. A letter confirming registration will be mailed or emailed upon receipt of registration forms and a deposit of \$250.00.**

**A final package with all details pertaining to coming to camp (packing, clothing lists, parent visits, travel plans and final invoices) will be mailed to all registered campers in late March.**

### **CANOE TRIP PROGRAM:**

The Massasauga Provincial Park, which is situated close to Hurontario's Loon Portage offers excellent, safe and interesting tripping for our younger campers. The Province now charges a small daily fee for each camper in the park. The details of this fee will be included in our final package.

Specialized trips in the Magnetewan, Restoule and Pickerel River Basins are available and, for the majority of our campers who are 12 - 13 years old, these trips will be a part of their summer program. There is an additional charge for these advanced trips to cover the high transportation costs. Trip forms with detailed outlines of these trips will be mailed with the confirmation package.

### **ADVANCED CANOE TRIP PROGRAM:**

All boys who are 14 year of age and older will participate in a canoe trip in a remote but safe environment in the Chapleau Game Preserve where we own a well equipped northern outpost. This is a popular program and we are limited as to the number of campers who can take this opportunity to explore northern Ontario. If you have a camper who is 13-14 years old, please register early.

### **WHITE WATER TRIPPING PROGRAM:**

For campers who are 15 or 16 years old, Hurontario offers the opportunity to experience the incredible fun of white water tripping. This program involves an excellent training course in the spring and a choice of five AMAZING river trips which vary from 10 days to 21 days in length. These trips are popular with senior campers and numbers are limited. In the spring, senior campers will have the opportunity to choose one of these river trips or our northern outpost (see above).

### **LEADERSHIP-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM:**

If a camper is 15 or turns 15 while at camp, he will be involved in our leadership-in-training program. This program, which has many facets, offers senior campers an opportunity to begin to work with younger campers, to organize camp activities, and to work on their own skills in preparation for becoming a staff member the next summer, provided the camper is successful in the leadership program. Please register your 15 year old camper now so he can take advantage of this excellent program. It is very beneficial and teaches leadership skills for both city and camp life.
